ANTI-VANDALISM ORDINANCE

MMDA Resolution No. 02-09, Series of 2002

Urging the Local Government Units of Metro Manila to enact a uniform ordinance against **VANDALISM** in Metro Manila and providing penalties for violation.

VANDALISM

-refers to the act of intentionally defacing, damaging or destroying another person's property. It is an issue that affects both property owners and the community.

PROHIBITED ACTS



Damaging or defacing any building, road, property or other thing by drawing or inscribing on any public or private property any word, caricature, or other acts without lawful authority of the owner in lawful control.

Posting or displaying on any public or private property any advertisement, bill or notice without the consent of the owner.



Hanging or displaying on or from any public or private property flag, banner or the like with any word, slogan, caricature, or symbol without the consent of the owner.



PENALTIES

FOR MUNICIPALITIES

- a fine of Php2,500 or an imprisonment of arresto menor in its maximum period (from 21 to 30 days) or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.



FOR CITIES

- a fine of Php5,000 or an imprisonment of arresto menor in its maximum period (from 21 to 30 days) or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.



VANDALISM is a crime against property and can be guilty of the crime of **MALICIOUS MISCHIEF** under Article 327 of the Revised Penal Code.

Elements of Malicious Mischief

1. That the offender deliberately caused damage to the property of another.
2. That such act does not constitute arson or other crimes involving destruction.
3. That the act of damaging another's property be committed merely for the sake of damaging it.
